

## 358 Sprints Handicapping (subject to change)

Any car not signed in by the beginning of motor starts will go to the rear of the heat or consolation events. The first two racing programs of the season will have the heat and feature line-up determined by the draw unless one of those events would be a time trial show. Any driver who does not compete in one of the first two (2) events will be handicapped to the rear of the heat race for a period of one event for a regular Williams Grove event. A regular handicapped event will be as follows: The line-up of the heat event will be determined by drivers season average money (lowest to Highest).

The feature will be lined up straight up from heat race finishes. The number of races run throughout the season divided by money earned computes the average money earned. Drivers entering Dirty Deed races at the speedway will be credited in regard to the number of races run, but money earned will not be included for handicapping

A driver who misses a race at Williams Grove and competes in another 410/360/358 sprint car race, upon his/her return will be lined up at the rear of the heat race for 1 week. The feature will be lined up straight up from heat race finishes.
